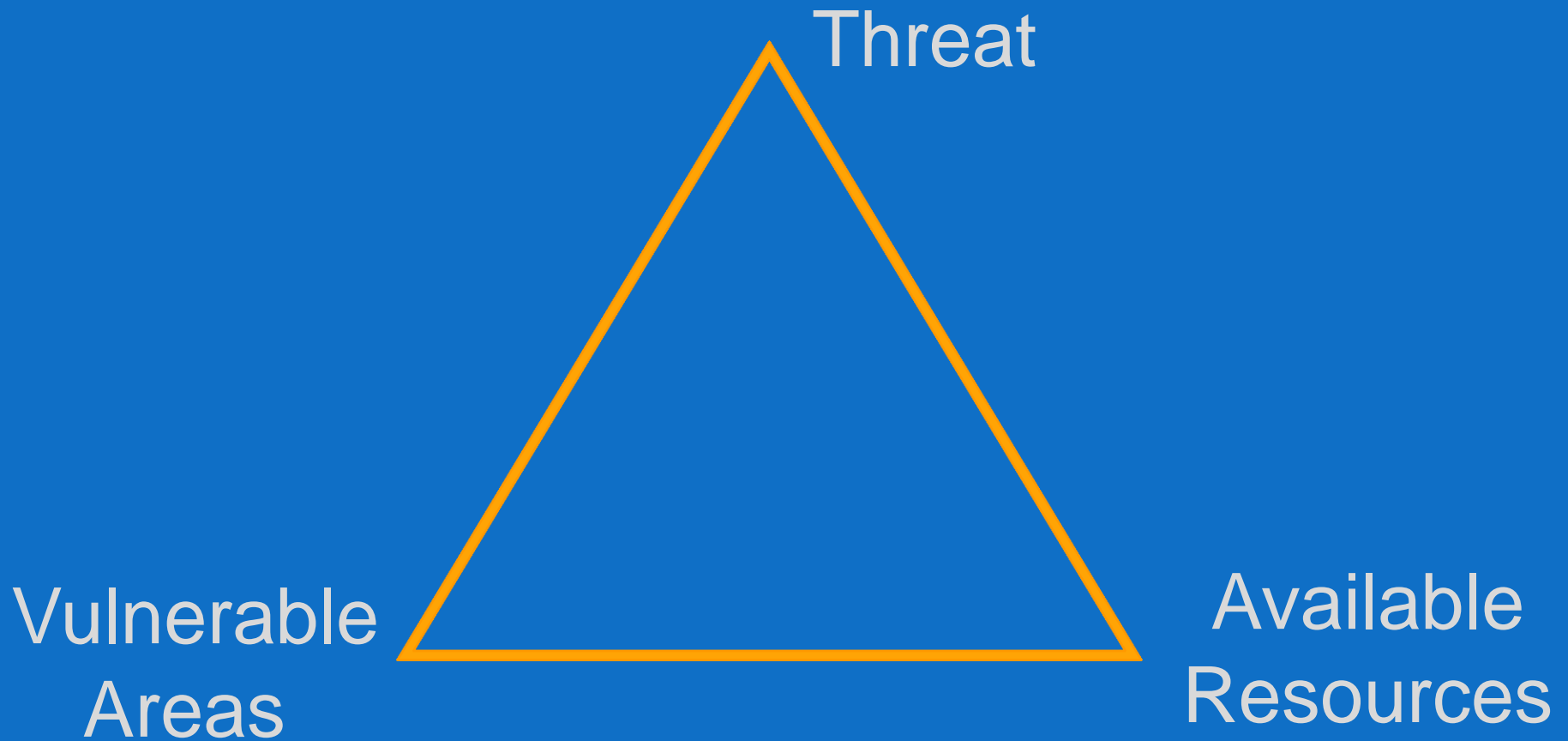

Philosophy

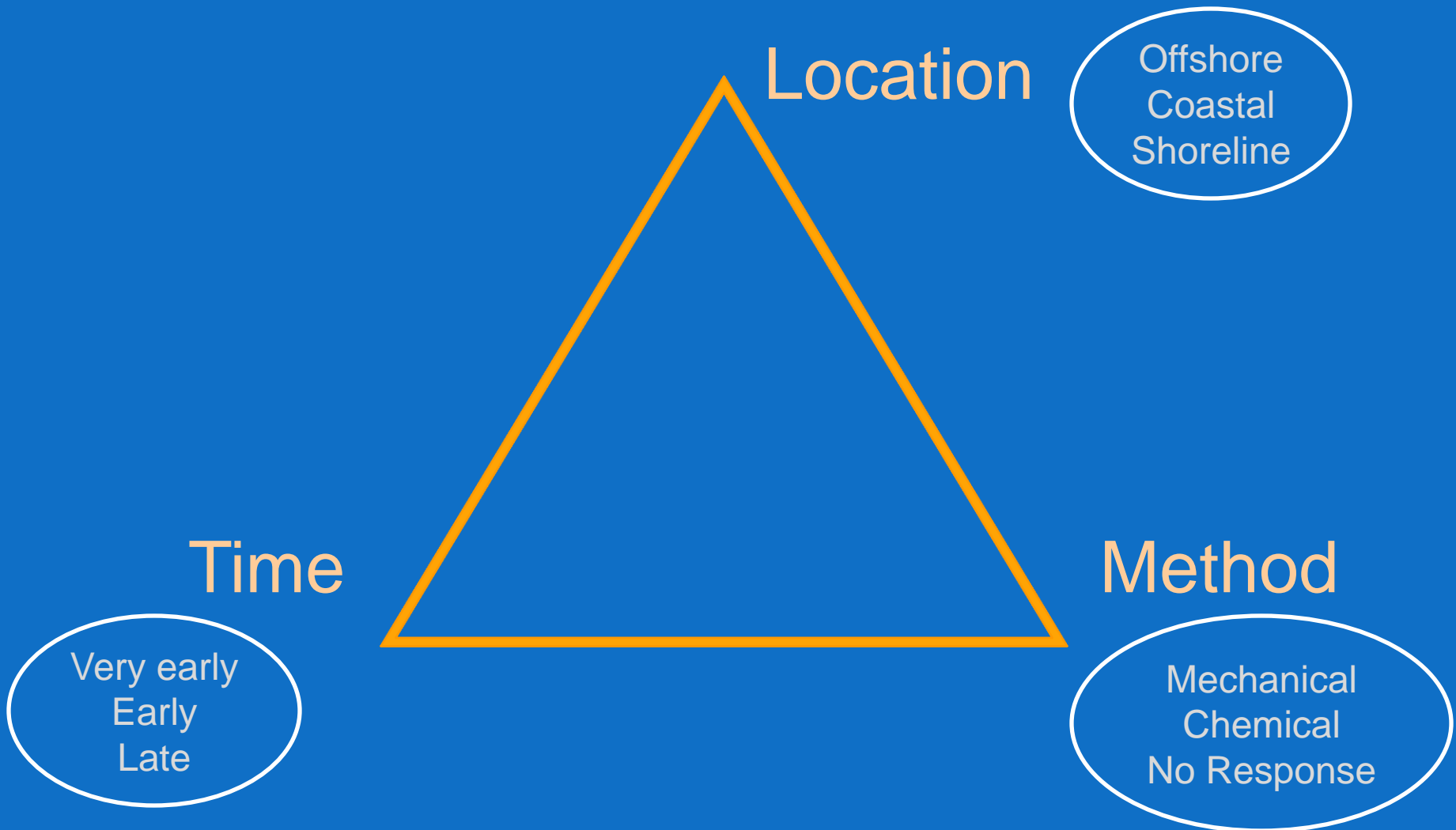
- Minimize Immediate Damage

Strategic Rules

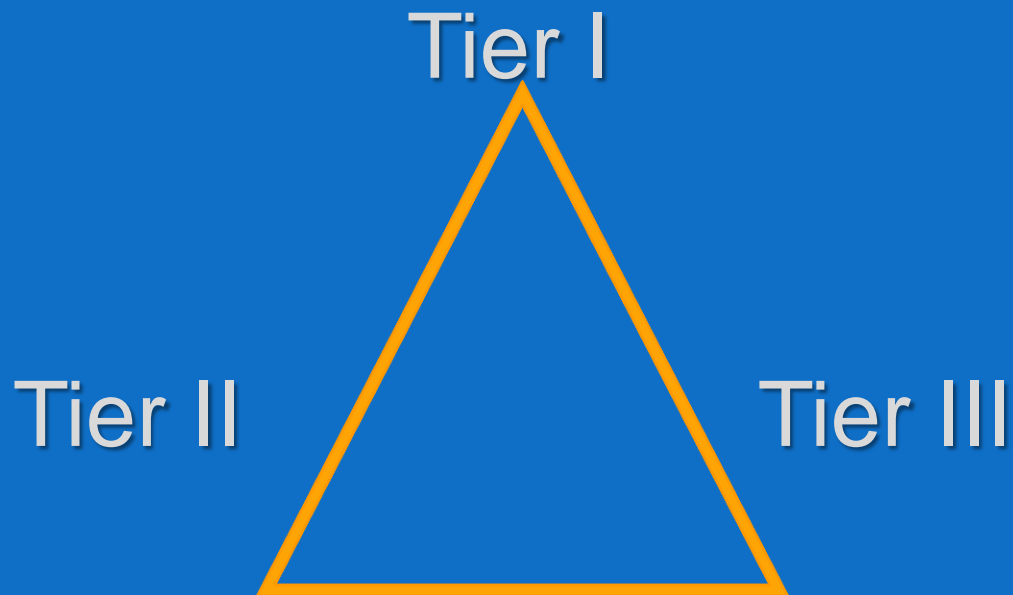
- Based on Net Environmental Benefit Analysis (NEBA)
- Close to the Source
- Avoid Reaching the Shoreline

Tiered Response



Tier	Volume	Response
I	Up to 10,000 liters (10 m ³)	Facility/Onboard Capability
II	Up to 1,000,000 liters (1000 m ³)	Tier I response including the capabilities of other industries, OSRO and government agencies
III	More than 1,000,000 liters (>1000 m ³)	Total national resources and foreign resources

Oil Spill Response Operation

- Initial/ Alerting Phase
- Planning/ Mobilization
- Response Operation
- Demobilization/ Termination

Initial Phase

- Receipt of Report and Notification of Authorities
- Collection of Information
- Preliminary Assessment and Verification of Report

Planning/ Mobilization Phase

- Planning Operation
- Identification of Response Priorities
- Mobilizing the Response Team

Response Operation

- Implement Oil Spill Countermeasures
- Briefing of Local and Government Officials

Demobilization

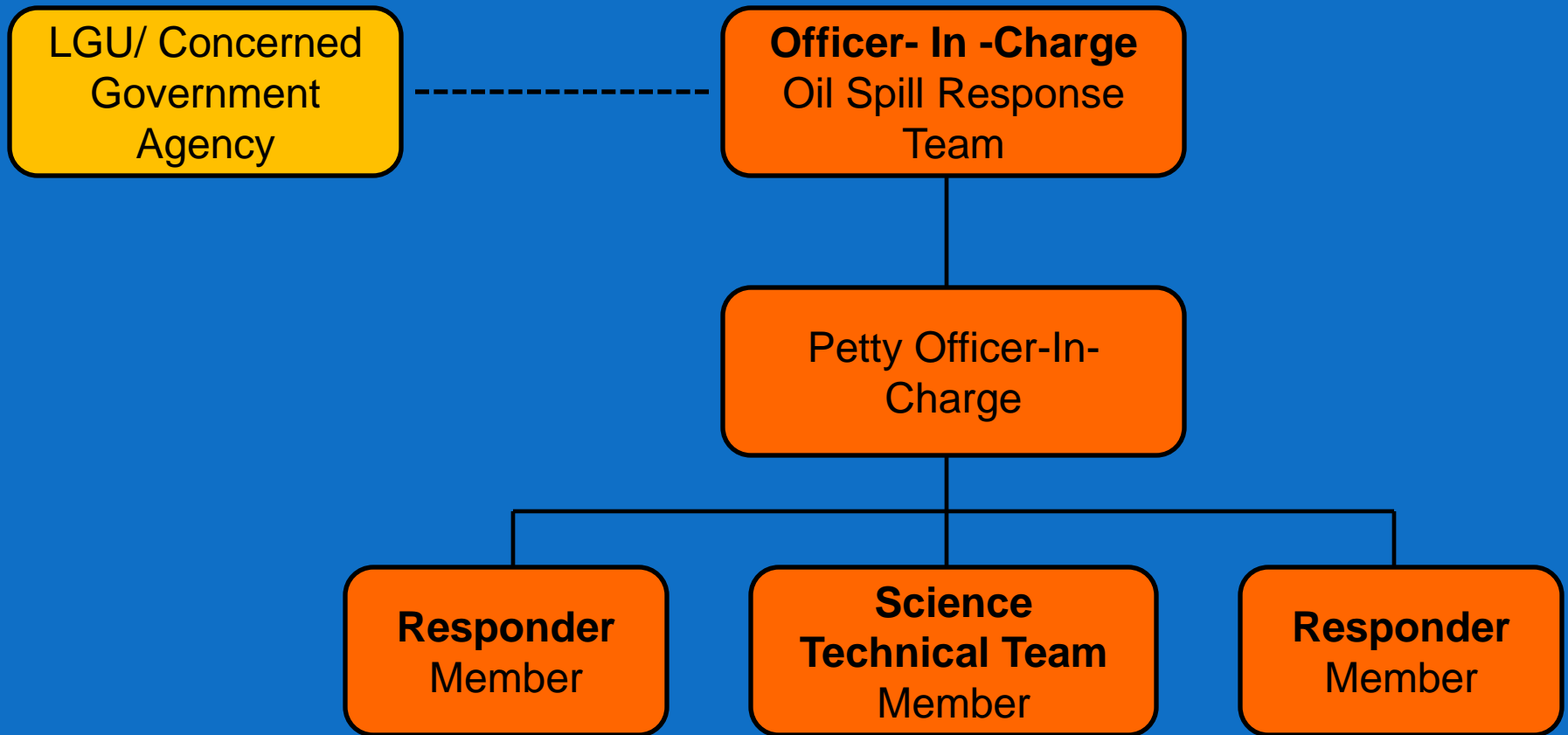
- Determine if Level of Clean-up is Acceptable
- Demobilize Resources
- Prepare Reports and Review Plans & Procedures

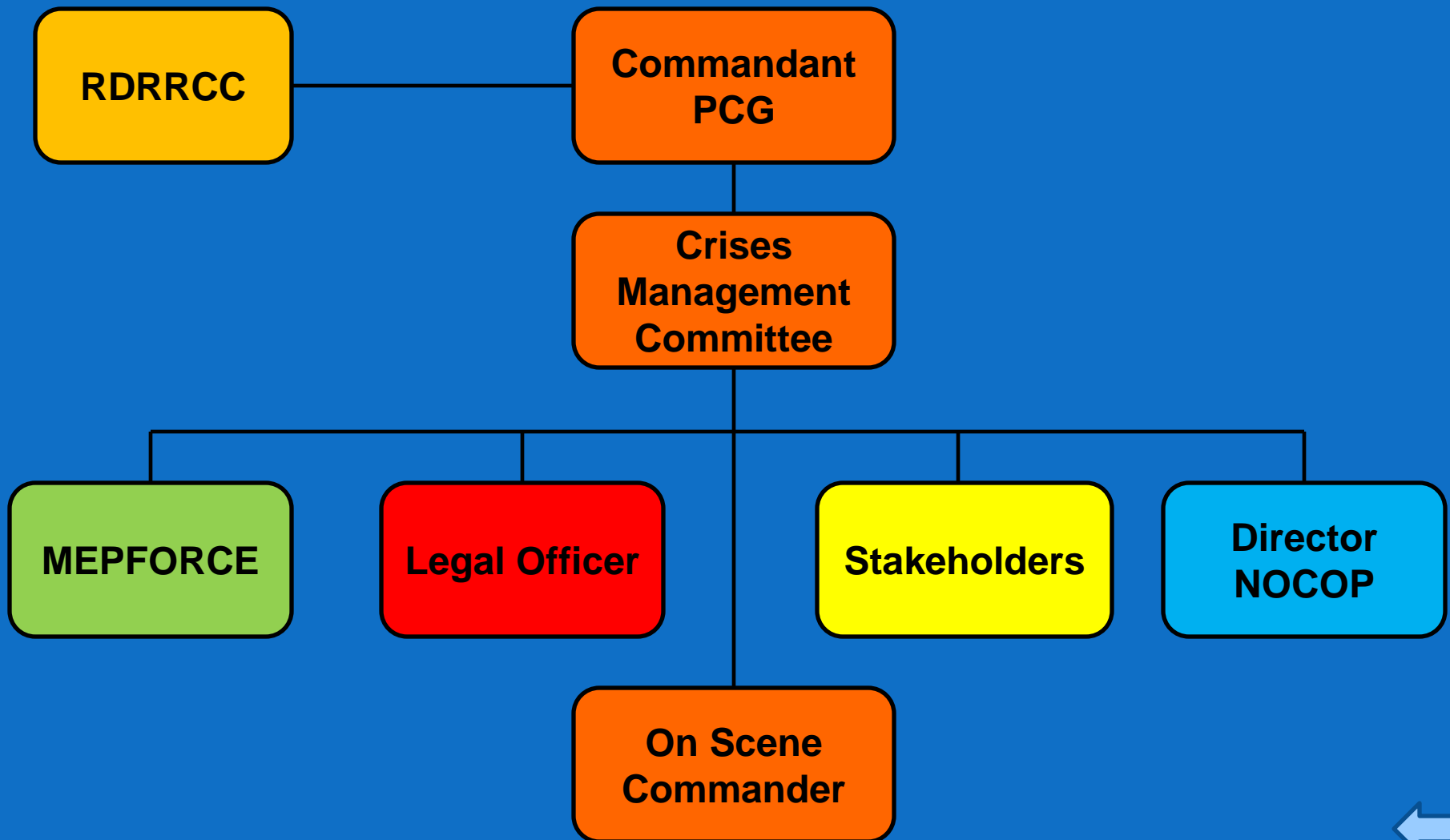
